Omar and I boarded up around under the eills of the house and I pulled the hay out of the way where we are feeding out of. Omar put a shelf in his bedroom a.m. P.m. Omar, Charles and I worked on the road. I put in about 1 hr. Charles and Omar worked 2 hrs and 45 min. Dailey and his father and 2 women come to look at the place.

Sat., Jan. 4 tem 16

Verna, Viola, Charles and I went to Medford got home about 3 Pm. We got 2 sacks of seed oats and a sack of rolled barley \$11.50 Oats \$8.40 rolled barley 310 fork handle .85 hammer handle 35, gass .91 gloves leather 298 cloth gloves .29

Sun., Jan. 5 tem 20 cloudy-drizzled pm

Omar and I cut some oak wood down by the big barn this four noon and Verna, Omar and I went down to Morris Brnes we went down 2 p.m. and started home 4 pm. I think the old white neck cow slunk a calf last night.

Mon., Jan. 6 tem 33 clear

Omar and I hauled a load of oak wood after we got don feeding and then we worked road 2 hrs a.m. P.m. worked road 2 hrs and 20 min.

Tues., Jan. 7 tem 23 clear- a little hazy 3

Omar and I worked on the road 3 hrs a.m. and we butchered Valentins calf this after noon.

Wed., Jan. 8 tem 28 clear

Omar, Verna and I took Valentine's calf over to Perless Market it weighed 274 and it brought \$71.26. We had our income tax made out and we paid \$47.00 in (amount was not clear).

Thurs., Jan. 9 tem 25

Omar and I did chors and out in 5 hrs on the road.

Fri., Jan. 10 tem 34 cloudy-a few lt. showers

I sharpened 2 picks and a ad (?) while Omar was cleaning the barns and feeding the calves grain and we worked on the road 4 3/4 hrs.

Sat., Jan. 11 tem 27 clear

Omar and I worked about 3 hrs on the road a.m. P.m. Omar and I went up to George Dawsons got back 3 P.m.

Sun., Jan. 12 tem 33 snow-the ground was white

Omar and I did chores and ground Omar's ax on the emery stone and Ernie and Hellen come and Omar and I met them over near the foot bridge and wheel their bacon over. They wanted us to smoke it a little for them. We play 4 games of Pinochle and we got 2 games a piece Hellen and I played Ernie and Verna. They started home about 4 pm Roney and Dick come out with them

Mon., Jan. 13 tem 28 snow

Omar and I worked on the road 5 hrs and 15 min It spit snow most of four noon but didnt pile up any

Tues., Jan. 14 tem 32 cloudy

Omar and I worked on the road 6 hrs

Wed., Jan. 15 tem 16 clear

Omar and I did chores and worked road 5 1/2 hrs

Thurs., Jan. 16 tem 16 clear

Omar and I worked road 5 1/2 hrs and we put a 100 lbs of carbide in the generator after dinner

Fri., Jan. 17 tem 16 clear

Omar and I worked on the road 2 hrs a.m. P.m. Verna, Omar and I went down to the store. Omar got a hair cut we got back 4 pm Our carbide plant went on the bum last night and we didnt have any gas when Omar tried to light the burners.

Sat., Jan. 18 tem 26 clear a.m. light showers
11 pm cloudy pm

Omar and I worked 3 hrs on the road I finished a bunch of hard rock and then we went down and cleaned the rocks out off the road down to Billy's Gulch We all took a bath as we wanted to clean up for the card party Those that was here, Jim Winningham Mammie Winningham Harry and Lill Dow and Buster and Joe, Grace and Gerald, Harvy, Omar, Verna and I. Jim got first prize and Mammie Booby prize was Harry and Lill

Sun., Jan. 19 tem 28 clear

Rosley, Lewis and Polky come as we was threw feeding Lewis and Polky went up to the Kinney Creek Devide hunting cougar but no luck Omar went over to Lodge with Mike

Mon., Jan. 20 tem 28 clear

I sharpened a pick while Omar cleaned the barns and we went down to work on the road 10am We worked 4 1/2 on the turn out

Tues., Jan. 21 tem 23 foggy a.m. clear pm

Omar and worked on the road 5 1/2 hrs

Wed., Jan. 22 tem 26 clear am-cloudy pm

Omar and I worked 6 hrs on the road

Thurs., Jan. 23 tem 37 cloudy

Omar and I worked 5 hrs on the road Fred Marquis and Don Dorthy come by where we was working they was cleaning the rocks out of the road up to the mine

Fri., Jan. 24 tem 37 clear a.m.-cloudy p.m.

Omar and I worked on the road 6 hrs.

Sat., Jan. 25 tem 30 ^{NOTE:} BAUCHMAN WAS MASTER OF GRANGE OF TINE. LIVED ON OLD CHICKEN RANCH NEAR BRIDGE.

Omar Verna and I went to Medford and we went up to see Bauchman to see if he needed any help as his car was on the bum he stoned at Rich and Jacksonville but they couldnt fix it so I gave him a start and he took it to the Nash garage and they fixed it in about 15 min and Omar and him went to Phoenix to Patona We got back home 5 p.m.

Sun., Jan. 26 tem 40 clear

I shod the team and Omar cleaned the bull corral and went over to Edds and got the saw

Mon., Jan. 27 tem 29 cloudy

Omar, Edd and I dusted 66 head of cattle in 5 hrs Guy Watkins was working on the Tellanphone line

Tues., Jan. 28 tem 32 5 in. snow

I fixed some molding around the bedroom doors in our bedroom a.m. P.m. I cleaned the bull shed and cleaned both sides of the drive way at the north end of big barn and cleaned the snow out of the trail to the wood shed and out to the toilet

Wed., Jan. 29 tem 32 clear a.m.-cloudy pm

Omar helped feed and went up to Kinney Creek divide he road twister up to the top and turned him loos and he come home. Omar went down Strait Gulch to where we killed the cougar and up to Chimney gulch gap and around and down Canacker (so?) I finished the chores and worked 2 1/2 hrs on the road a.m. P.m. I went over and got the mail

Thurs., Jan. 30 tem 32 cloudy

Omar and I worked on the road 4 hrs I cleaned where the water run in the shed where we load hay

Fri., Jan. 31 tem 25 cloudy

Omar and I went to work on the road and when Omar looked at his something had sprung one of his traps and ate most of the bait and Omar come back and got the dogs but I guess it was Moria Byrne's dog that sprung the trap as Omar got back as we quit for dinner I worked 2 1/2 hrs pm

Sat., Feb. 1 tem 38 clear

Omar and I worked on the road 4 hrs worked until 1 p.m. and didn't go back down in the afternoon. We went to the Grange hall to a special meeting that Baughman called. Edd and Viola went down with us.

Sun., Feb. 2 tem 43 cloudy

Light shower this morning. Omar and I worked on the road until 1 pm worked 4 hrs. Albert and Alma Luels and her husband, Ernie, Hellen, Russell Roney come about 3 pm and left about 4.30.

Mon., Feb. 3 tem 27 clear

Omar and I worked on the road 4 hrs a.m. and we butchered Glory's calf pm. Jim Winningham went up Kinney with the F. S. truck after poles for a cattle yard down at McKee Camp ground.

Tues., Feb. 4 tem 25 clear

Omar, Verna Edd Finley and I went to Medford. We took Glory's calf over it weighed 224# at 27c \$60.48 we got a sack of mash and a sack of barley and 6 cans of dry rub.

Wed., Feb. 5 tem 26 clear

Omar and I worked road 4 1/4 hrs. We hauled a load of hay to the cow barn. Verna went down to Forts to a meeting. I sharpened my pick after I had dinner.

Thurs., Feb. 6 tem 26 clear

Omar and I took Verna and Viola down to the stoar to get their hair fixed. Grack Buck and Alma Collings come down to get their hair fixed but the barber didn't have time to fix Almas hair. She is going down to have her hair fixed in the morning. Omar and I come up this side with the car to Billys Gulch and worked road and went back to the stoar for dinner and come back and worked until 4.30 and went back down after Verna and we come back this side this evening.

Fri., Feb. 7 tem 35 clear/cloudy

Omar and I worked on the road just this side of Billys Gulch 6 hrs on the road.

Sat., Feb. 8

Omar and I worked road. Leora and Edd Pease come about 6 pm. Edd went home about 10.30 a.m. Leora went home with Verna and I Mo morning. Lewis Charles Mary and Roslev come about 9 pm and I went home about 5 pm evening. Lewis and Charles went up to Steaves Peak hunting Sunday they got back 1.30 pm.

Sun., Feb. 9 tem 35

I worked road about 3 hrs and Omar worked road 2 hrs.

Mon., Feb. 10 tem 36 cloudy

Verna and I went to town. Verna had some teeth filled \$32. Leora went back with us.

Tues., Feb. 11 tem ? cloudy/rain

Omar and I helped Edd dust his cattle got done 11 a.m. started raining 1030 a.m. and still raining at 630 pm Verna washed Omar and I took the car around to the garage

Wed., Feb. 12 tem 45 cloudy/rain

Omar and I hauled a load of hay to the cow barn and took the teeth out of the springtooth harrow a.m. and Pm we sharpened the teeth and sharpened 2 picks and put the teeth back in the harrow and pulled the drag out where we could get at it with the team

Thurs., Feb. 13 tem 36 clear

I run the drag over the field to mash the cow piles I out in about 6 hrs Omar worked at cleaning the bull correll

Fri., Feb. 14 tem 39 cloudy

Omar wheeled the mud out of the bull correll a.m. and cleaned the rocks out of the road Pm I run the drag over the field 6 hrs

Sat., Feb. 15 tem 41 cloudy/rain in evening

I finished dragging the field and I took Omar over to Jacksonville a.m. I got back 12 noon Pm I run the springtooth 3 ways over the little patch by the gate that goes into the big barn and we went to a special grange meeting got home about 1230

Sun., Feb. 16 tem 42

Verna and I went over to Ernie's and Hallen's after Omar and We ate dinner with them their family was all there including Melba Area and Don Swanson was there to Leora and Swaney came home with us.

I sprungtoothed 6 hrs Omar worked cleaning and weeding the little garden by the barn

Tues., Feb 18 tem 29 clear

Omar, Edd and I dehorned 13 head a.m. and dusted them Pm we dehorned 8 head of Edd Finley's got threw about 330 and when I got home I pruned until 5 pm.

Wed., Feb. 19 tem 36 clear

Edd Pease come out last night and went back this morning and Leora and Soney went back with him Edd and I fixed the drain pipe in the stationery tubs this morning I started springtoothing 10 a.m. and quit 430 pm 5 hrs Omar and I hauled a load of hay to the cow barn Omar weeded the garden by the barn and pulled some corn stalks

Thurs., Feb 20 tem 27 clear

Omar and I feed the cattle and hauled a load of hay to the cow barn and I finished springtoothing the square piece and got a good start on the piece just the other side of the 2 oaks the other side of the swale. Omar pulled and burned corn stalks. Cooper* and Tedro was here this after noon

Fri., Feb. 21 tem 29

Alma Collings and Albert come down this morning to help mark and brand calves. Edd, Albert Omar and I marked and branded 25 head we got done 1 pm I sprung tooth 3 hrs this after noon We put 8 weaners in the morning

Sat., Feb. 22 tem 28 clear

Omar and I feed the cattle and I built a feed box to feed the calves grain in I started working in the field about 9 a.m. and quit about 5 pm 7 hrs Omar set stakes and put the feed box up and finished cleaning the corn fodder off

Sun., Feb. 23 tem 28 clear

I springtooth until 11-30 a.m. Omar worked with the berries a.m. Ernie, Russel, Honey and Hellen come 11-30 a.m. and started home about 4 pm 4 low, Buster and Joe come about 4-30 and started home 5.30 pm Omar and I didn't work this after noon

W. L. W. S.

Mon., Feb. 24 tem 30 clear

I finished pruning the two peach trees here by the house and started springtooth 9 a.m. and worked the rest of day springtooth 6 1/2 hrs Omar worked cleaning out the berries

Tues., Feb. 25 tem 28 clear

I run the springtooth 6 hrs Omar look after cattle that went down the road and worked cleaning berries

Wed., Feb. 26 tem 28 clear

Verna and I went to Medford Omar went down to the store to get his hair cut but couldn't get it cut as Helli Dasher went to a funeral. Omar come home with Jary (Gerald) Buck. Omar worked at pruning berries this after noon

Thurs., Feb. 27 tem 38 cloudy

Verna and Omar planted garden out by the barn they planted pease and set out 2 bunches onions and planted radishes and swiss chard I run the springtooth 6 hrs Omar left 1 pm to go over to town to lodge

Fri., Feb. 28 tem 26 partly cloudy

I sowed oats on the squir piece and springtooth and harrowed them in and run the drag over it and picked the rock off. Omar finished the berries and went down to Morris Byrne's and drove 10 head of cattle back

Sat., Mar. 1 tem 36 cloudy

Started raining 5 pm I sowed the piece the other side of the 2 big oaks out to the ditch that runs down to where Art and Lewis mined got done 5 pm. Omar dug Verna's flower bed up and put a fence around it. Leora, Soney and Edd come about 8 pm

Sun., Mar. 2 tem 39 rain

Omar, Edd, and I put the new handles on the Oliver Plow got done 1 :m I put the rest of the after noon fixing ball collars and I put a center clip on a singletree. I saw 5 head of Edd cattle up on Bald mountain this evening

Mon., Mar. 3 tem 35 cloudy/showery

I pruned nearly 5 trees. Omar went down to Moris Byrnes to look after the cattle he got back 12.30 and he dug post holes and set 3 post nm. Edd Finley went up on Bald Mountain after 8 head of his cattle

Tues., Mar. 4 tem 37 cloudy

I pruned 5 trees to day Omar dug post holes and set post

Wed., Mar. 5 tem 32

Omar and Edd went up to Lick Gulch and they brought 12 head of Edd's cattle down from Bald Mountain. Omar got home 4 pm. I pruned fruit trees. Omar and I started the cattle up Kinney Creek this morning. I took Verna and Viola down to the Hall I got back 2 pm

Thurs., Mar. 6 tem 27 cloudy

Omar and I started the cattle up Kinney Creek this morning I sowed some oats and sprungtooth them in and run the spike tooth harrow about 1/2 hr. Omar set post

Fri., Mar. 7 tem 36 cloudy

I sowed some oats and sprungtooth a.m. P.m. I run the spike tooth over it to cover the oats and drag all but about 1 acre. Omar went down to Moris Byrnes to look after the cattle and set some more fence posts

Sat., Mar. 8 tem 37

Omar and I started the cattle up near Buck Gulch and I finished grazing the oats over by the Turkey stand a.m. P.m. I run the springtooth over the little piece and the one by the gate that goes in to the big barn and the piece below the big barn. Omar set post. We went to grange in the evening

Sun., Mar. 9 tem 43 rain

Started raining about 5 and has been raining steady until 730 and is still raining hard. Omar and I started the cattle up in the oafs (sp?) this morning got back 11 a.m. and finished the chores and that about all we done except chores. Omar went over to Scovills this afternoon. After Grange we danced until about 130 there was some folks come from Rich 2 from Eagle Point and one from Rich they played acorden a electric steel gytar and a drum. There was 54 there for lunch. Verna, Omar, Fred Lorn and I was on the serving comitty.

Mon., Mar. 10 tem 40

Verna, Omar and I went to Medford. I got a new suit and over coat the suit cost \$39.50 and the over coat 32.50 and we got 4 rods of wire fence \$33.00 and we got 2 sacks of seed oats \$8.40 2 sacks of rolled barley \$6.00

Tues., Mar. 11 tem 37 clear

Omar and I took the box off the wagon and put the hay rack on this morning and Omar went down the road on this side to see if there was any cattle going to cross the river he took a shovel with him and cleaned the slide off the road and cleaned the rocks off I put the rack in shape to go after a load of hay a.m. P.m. I went over after the mail and pruned fruit trees the rest of the time.

Wed., Mar. 12 tem 27 clear

Omar and I started the cattle above Edda nine and we started up to Fred Dorns after hay. We got a ton of hay today got back 4 pm

Thurs., Mar. 13 tem 29 clear

Omar, Edd and I went down to Star to a stock meeting and we organized a stock association. It includes Dan Boney, Bert Harr, John Collings, Albert Collings, Gerald Buck, Ben and George Dawson, E. H. Finley, (Moris Byrnes and Amos McKee) Omar and I. Ben Dawson was elected President I was elected Vice President. E.H. Finley is Secretary and Treasurer. Albert Collings Gerald Buck as advisory board. We got home 2 pm. I pruned fruit trees until 5 pm Omar fixed the fence down about the the mouth of Kinney.

Fri., Mar. 14 tem 31

Omar and I started the cattle up the ditch and Omar drove them up and I come back and got the team and wagon and went down by the bridge and up to Fred Dorns after a load of hay We got home 5 p.m. Lorn Cooper called this evening and said if I wanted to turn my cattle out 10 days early and get them in 10 days earlier this fall that I could if it was all right with the boys in this association

Sat., Mar. 15 tem 33 clear

Omar and I started the cattle up the ditch and Omar took them on up to Bolder and I come back and sowed 3 piece to oats here by the barns Omar put linolium in his room a.m. P.m. he helped unload a load of hay and chored around the rest of the afternoon. We are going down to the dance

Sun., Mar. 16 tem 34 clear

We went to the dance last night got home about 2 they had a big crowd. Omar, Edd, Albert Colling and I marked and branded and vaccinated 18 head of calves got home 12 noon I pruned a part of a apple tree this after noon. Omar oiled some bell collars.

Mon., Mar. 17 tem 37 clear

Omar helped up to the Y with the cattle and I took them up to where the Steamboat trail turns off. I finished pruning a.m. Omar sprayed all day I worked in the strawberries.

Tues., Mar. 18 tem 45 cloudy
 LESTER ANDERSEN, EDD'S NEPHEW

Omar, Edd, Lester*, and I went up to help Albert Collings Mark and brand calves and put some bells on. We got back about 12 noon. I worked in the strawberries. Omar sprayed fruit trees.

Wed., Mar. 19 tem 35 clear

Omar herded cattle all day I went down and watched the cattle while Omar come up for dinner. I worked in the strawberries and Omar and I put 9 bells on the cows and put clappers in 3 bells. Verna and I worked a little while pulling the old weeds in the garden this evening and we burned the old grass along the fence.

Thurs., Mar. 20 tem 38 clear

Omar and I did chores and herded the cattle to keep them from crossing the river. There is 65 head in the feed lot tonight.

Fri., Mar. 21 tem 36 partly cloudy

Omar, Verna, Edd Finley and I drove 65 head of cattle up to the foot of Mule Mt. this morning and 4 pm there was 16 head was coming back and I met them over at Morris upper corner and I drove them back. I hewed some weeds out of the garden and Omar and I took the hay rack off and put the box back on. Omar went over after the mail and brought Edds blocks and reins to lift the hay rack with.

Sat., Mar. 22 tem ? rain

Omar Verna and I went to town. We got back about 430 pm.

Sun., Mar. 23 tem 36 cloudy/showery

Omar and I hauled a load of third crop of hay from the big barn and we got ready to go to town to Russels and Malha Ayres wedding. We got back about 6 pm.

Mon., Mar. 24 tem 25

I finished the chores after breakfast and hewed one row of berries and hewed the garden out by the barn and hewed some chick weed in the garden by the house. Omar and Edd started cleaning they started up at Edds pipe and cleaned up to Frincheys cabin.

Tues., Mar. 25 tem 35 clear

I hewed in the garden out by the barn and a row of berries and I dug chick weed and cleaned 2 rows of strawberries up by the cellar. Omar and Edd cleaned ditch they got up to the draw this side of Boulder.

Wed., Mar. 26 tem 30 clear

I finished cleaning out the strawberries and I picked the sprouts up where I pruned. Verna helped me for a while but quit finish. I burned some of the berry vines down by the orchard. Omar and Edd worked ditch. Fred* helped this afternoon.

FRED DORN

Thurs., Mar. 27 tem 35 clear

Omar, Edd and Fred cleaned ditch up to the draw the other side of lunch(sp?) gulch. I cleaned the berrys of along the ditch by the orchard and at the lower end of the orchard and cleaned the bean poles off

Fri., Mar. 28 tem 41 cloudy

It started raining 5:40 pm. Omar, Edd and Fred cleaned ditch they got up to half way between the short pipe and the gravel reservoir I grubed 2 pear trees and hewed three rows of strawberries a.m. P.m. I cut some brush along the ditch where the willows grew down by the turn out of the first ditch that the trail crosses and cleaned it up to the cellar

Sat., Mar. 29 tem 46 cloudy

Omar and Edd cleaned ditch 4 hrs. It started raining 5 pm and rained fairly hard until 4 pm. I cleaned ditch 4 hrs cleaned up to where the telephone line crossed the point over by the first gulch Omar and Edd got home about 2pm

Sun., Mar. 30 tem 48 cloudy

A few light showers. I went up Kinney and turned the water out of the ditch as the hard rain raised Kinney Cr. and I went up and cleaned ditch up to the first gulch Come back at 11 a.m. Ernest, Hellen, Roney, Melba, Russel, Mary Rosley and Lewis was here. Rosley Mary and Lewis was here for supper. Omar went over to Scovells a.m.

Mon., Mar. 31 tem 36 cloudy

I finished cleaning the (ditch?) up to Edds pipe got done 11 a.m. and I came down and cut down and cut the big willow out over at the ditch over by the foot bridge. Pm I cleaned the ditch down nearly to the turkey stand. Omar Edd and Fred cleaned ditch they got up to the first point just above Grouse Cr. west gate

Tues., Apr. 1 tem 34 cloudy

A light shower 4 pm. I cleaned ditch down to where it runs in the river and cleaned the ditch and washed it out where the sink dumps in. Omar, Edd and Fred cleaned ditch they got up to Johns barn

Wed., Apr. 2 tem ?

I run springtooth over the ground in the orchard and cleaned some little ditches in the grain ground that a springtooth. Omar went up Kinney Cr. and made a lick and bunched the hay that was scattered around in the big barn

Thurs., Apr. 3 tem 37

I cleaned ditch in the field Omar, Edd, Fred, Frank and John cleaned on the main ditch Don Marten and Charles came about 6 pm

Fri., Apr. 4 tem 37 cloudy

I cleaned ditch in the field. Omar, Edd, Fred, Frank and John finished cleaning the main ditch. Don and Charles went up on top of Bald Mt. a.m. and went down to Ames this afternoon.

Sat., Apr. 5 tem 44

I cleaned ditch in the field. Omar cleaned ditch in the field about 3 hrs. Omar went down to Pearl Byrnes to get his hair cut.

Sun., Apr. 6 tem 32 clear a.m., cloudy p.m.

I finished cleaning the ditch that is on this end of the squir piece that Lewis helped clean up and we went down to the hall to Easter services this morning and we went down to the 7 days Services in the evening. Edd and Leora come out about 10 a.m. and went home about 4 p.m.

Mon., Apr. 7 tem 34 cloudy

Rained a good shower this evening. Omar and I drove the milk cow up to where Harthen had his tent and we hauled manure and cleaned the weeds and rocks off the corn ground and we butchered Harts calf this evening. Harts little boy got his hand blew off with a giant powder cap. The telephone out fit went on a strike in Medford.

Tues., Apr. 8 tem 38

Verna, Omar and I went to Medford. Omar staid in to go to Phoenix to grange. We had our State income tax made out. Mr. Danten (sp?) fixed it up for us we gave him \$2.00. We took harts calf to Fearless Market it brought \$83.34. I ordered 3000# of hay from Sampsen's (sp?) Lewis will bring it out in the morning.

Wed., Apr. 9 tem 35 cloudy

I hauled manure a.m. Lewis got here with the hay from Sampsons 1230 p.m. Omar and I hauled 3 loads of manure and 2 loads of weeds the hay and delivery was \$62.26.

Thurs., Apr. 10 tem 44 cloudy

Omar and Edd went up and put a head of water in the ditch they got back about 5 pm. I hauled 6 loads of manure.

Fri., Apr. 11 tem 30 clear

I hauled 6 loads of manure from the horse barn. Omar and Edd went up to the head of the main ditch to put water in they got back about 4 pm and the river was muddy this morning and Omar and Edd went up to see if our ditch was broke and Fred saw the muddy water and went up the ditch and found it was washing out just this side of Grouse Creek nine where it leeke before. We went down to Mamie and Jim's for supper and played cards until 11.

Sat., Apr. 12 tem 34 clear

I finished hauling manure on the garden and I run the disk over the gardens and I run the spike tooth over after the disk. The ditch washed out where Omar and Edd and Fred fixed it just this side of Grouse Creek.

Sun., Apr. 13 tem ? clear

I went up to first gulch to see if the sheen was around and went over to Edds to look at some cattle and there was 9 of outs there.

Mon., Apr. 14 tem 44 clear, 90 deg at 1 p.m.

I plowed the gardens and harrowed them and run the drag over them. Omar, Fred and Edd worked putting a pipe in where the ditch broke.

Tues., Apr. 15 tem 42 clear, 86 deg 1 pm

I disked the orchard and plowed it all but about an hour plowing to finish. Omar and Edd went up to see about the pipe they put in this side of Grouse Creek they got back 2 pm. Omar helped me plow along the apple trees.

Wed., Apr. 16 tem 42 clear a.m., cloudy this eve

I started irrigating the pasture 8 a.m. and I finished the pasture this evening and I worked the ground down in the orchard between times to change the water. Omar and Verne planted some garden here by the house. Omar and I shoveled the ditch out down by the big barn.

Thurs., Apr. 17 tem 44 cloudy

It sprinkled a little. I irrigated. Cleaned ditch a.m. P.m. I irrigated and worked the corn ground and drag the plowed ground in the orchard. Omar cleaned ditch and put the water on the straw berries up by the cellar.

Fri., Apr. 18 tem 42

Omar went salting he saw H G(?) lead 10 head on Gray back and heard 2 more bells in Dough Holler. Verne, Edd and I went to Medford we got home 2 P.m. There was 8 head come in here this evening.

Sat., Apr. 19 tem 45 cloudy

I irrigated and sowed oats in the orchard and Omar and I drove 8 head of cattle back across the river and drove them up back of Morris Burnes corner to where the Mule Creek Trail swings back on the ridge. Omar planted some carrots and Verne and Omar put out some tomato plants. Scovels and Finleys was here for supper and we played a couple of games of 500.

Sun., Apr. 20 tem 35 cloudy

A light shower at 330. I cleaned ditch and irrigated. Tom and Leuely (Luella)* Dunning (Dunnington) and Mr and Mrs Vanzelder and Mrs and Mr Ray Coleman come about 430 and Tom butchered hart. Omar put a hundred lbs of carbide in the generator and went to a grange meeting down at our hall.
*Luella, Verne's sister.

Mon., Apr. 21 tem 42 cloudy

I irrigated and cleaned ditch Omar set out a row of strawberries and planted corn Hearled (Harold) Reed come out and got Hart

Tues., Apr. 22 tem 32 clear

Verna Omar and I went down to Rich to the oction but didnt buy anything

Wed., Apr. 23 tem 33 clear

I irrigated and cleaned ditch Omar planted corn and Omar and Verna cut potatoes I mowed the grass out of the ditch that runs here by the house and cut the grass down to the road. Omar gathered it up and feed it to the cows and horses and the bull

Thurs., Apr. 24 tem 33 clear

I irrigated and cleaned ditch Omar planted the potatoes a.m. P.m. Omar put the water on the garden out by the barn and out the water on the tomatoes, melons and the strawberries that Verna dn him set out

Fri., Apr. 25 tem 32 clear

I irrigated and cut grass out off the ditch that has the floom Omar planted sweet corn and red beans

Sat., Apr. 26 tem 36 clear, high 80

I irrigated. Omar planted cucumbers and howed some in the gardens a.m. P.m. Omar headed for Medford I put the water on some of the cow pasture this evening

Sun., Apr. 27 tem 37 clear a.m., cloudy p.m.

Verna and I went Johny Highebothen's (John Higginbotham)* for dinner and look at a moing machine and rake I bought them for 100.00 and Clarence Buck and I are going after them tomorrow. Omar was at Dashers Stoor**as we come home and he rode home with us. We got home 6 P.m.

*John's wife was Verna's aunt, Mary McKee H.
**Dashers store was next to McKee Bridge, now known as Upper Applegate Store.

Mon., Apr. 28 tem 37

I got Clarence Buck to truck a mower and rake that I bought from Johny Higginbotham. Omar and I went with Clarence to help load them we got here about 2 pm and Omar and I went back with Clarence. Down to Floyd McKee's place and when we got back I fixed the ditches so the water would run in the river I gave John Hig \$100.00 for the rake and mower \$1.00 for a single tree I gave Clarence \$10.00 for hauling maching and rake Albert Collings got 50# of potatoes \$100.00

Tues., Apr. 29 tem 48 cloudy

I cleaned ditch in the field Omar sawed 8 blocks of the big fir up by the Y

Wed., Apr. 30 tem 38 clear

Omar, Larn Cooper and I went salting. We salted 42 head 13 on Gray Back and Curiosity there was one on Gray Back and we saw 15 of Morris Byrnes in Lick Gulch and 25 of Bert Hars on Gray Back. We got back 730 pm. Omar shot one shot and got what he shot at.

Thurs., May 1 tem 45 clear high 90

I cleaned ditch and started the Helems cow and calf and a long yearling steer and spunky up Mile Creek a.m. Omar split 3 tier of wood and about 430 Pm. Omar and I hauled the wood. We finished hauling 6 Pm. I hewed strawberries until 430 and hewed 2 rows after supper.

Fri., May 2 tem 47 clear

Omar, Verna and I went to Medford. Edd, Leora and Rosley ate dinner with Verna and I at the Oyster Loaf. I got 6 yards and 6 yard bolts for the case machine and 6 bolts for the rake. yards 249 yard bolts 60 Rake bolts 40 over all under wear sox and suspenders \$7.95 overalls \$ 2.85.

Sat., May 3

Omar and I weeded and irrigated the garden and went to a dance at the Grange hall. I took Omar down to Offenbachers to get Lance to cut his hair.

Sun., May 4 tem 44 2 a.m. clear

I cultivate the berries and tomatoes and watermelons and berries and the pasture by the barn and between the first cut and the gulch that comes down to the gate. Edd and Lee and Richard Shlay and seney(?) come about 10 a.m. and started home 3 pm.

Mon., May 5 tem 51 clear high 90 doz

I mowed with scythe around the house and fixed the dams in the ditch so the water that run by while Edd is irrigating would go down on the piece down where Lewis set out plum trees and I put in the rest of my time hewing corn and I turned the water on Vernas flowers and irrigated the yard. Omar hewed in the garden here by the house.

Tues., May 6 tem 49 clear a.m., cloudy pm

Omar and I hewed garden a.m. and I re planted the beans and sweet corn. Omar and I went to Medford after his phonograph. we started at 2 Pm and got back 530 Pm.

Wed., May 7 tem 46 cloudy

It started raining about 4 pm and is still raining 630. Omar and I cleaned ditch in the field a.m. and I cultivated corn and berries and made rows for water in the potatoes and I raked the potatoes over with the rake. Omar hewed garden and cut a load of feed for the cows and took the cultivator down to the potato patch and we raked some hay in that I cut along the ditch that we cleaned.

Thurs., May 8 tem ? cloudy

I started irrigated 9 a.m. I irrigated the cow pasture and mowed blackberry vines in the south end of pasture Omar sawed wood Edd come over to help saw 2 on and went home 5 pm

Fri., May 9 tem 8 on 44 cloudy

I irrigated and cleaned the berry vines off that I cut yesterday and I cut some more berries this after noon and cut hay for the stock Edd went salting

Sat., May 10 clear

I irrigated and mowed blackberry vines and mowed ditch Omar and Edd sawed wood and we went to Grange got home 2 a.m. Sunday

Sun., May 11 tem high 70 clear

I mowed ditch and Omar helped shock and pack it in a.m. Ernie, Helen Roney, Lewis, Rosley Charles, Mary and Genie the baby that Rosley is taking care of come about 12 noon and left about 5 pm. I didnt do any thing but irrigate this after noon.

Mon., May 12 tem 40

Clear most of the day. A few clouds this evening I irrigated and mowed a ditch and cut a few blackberry vines and Verna and I took the car around to the garage Omar, Fred Dorn and *Bawken worked down to the hell digging a well they dug 11 ft and got water

Tues., May 13 tem 46 clear

I irrigated and went up and cleaned the Grouse Cr. rack Omar went up on the hill a.m. and split wood 3 hrs 2m

Wed., May 14 tem 34 clear

I irrigated and mowed the ditch along the trail and gathered the hay and wheeled it in for the stock Omar split wood 4 hrs a.m. and Grace Duck, Lillian Helms, Omar, Alma, Verna and I went to Central Point to the contest Central Point won \$30.00 Gold Hill got \$25.00 and Eagle Point \$15.00

Thurs., May 15

I irrigated. Omar split wood a.m. Rich come down to cut wood 130 ms and the saw was dull and he left 4 pm to take it over to have Edd file it Bill Rich come with him

Fri., May 16 tem 41 clear

I irrigated Omar and Bill Rich tried to fix the wood saw Fred Rich come about 1030 and they was here for dinner and they loaded the wood saw in the truck and took to get it fixed. Leora and Edd come just as dinner was ready and started home about 2 pm

Sat., May 17 clear

Irrigated Omar, Billie Rich and Fred Rich sawed wood with drag saw. They sawed one tree except about one hr work

Sun., May 18 tem 41 clear

Omar and Edd sawed a fir for wood up by the Y. I irrigated the berries, beans and corn with the water before Fred Dorn took it all. Omar trimmed the tree a.m. but didnt work this after noon but hewed the garden out by the barn. Glory had a calf some time this four noon.

Mon., May 19 tem 43 clear

I tried the machine gerds that I got to see if they would fit and fixed fence down where the old road goes down to the old ford where Art Hulmes (?) and Lewis started to mine and went up and hunted glory and milked her out a.m. Billy Rich and Omar sawed wood all day and finished sawing. Verna and I went over to Medford to sign some papers for Edd and Laura Pesse. We got home 530 Pm.

Tues., May 20 tem 45 clear

I mowed the grass along the ditch here by the house and ground the scythe and I ground one bit of my ax and I mowed some needle grass down by the chicken yard a.m. Pm I straightened the horse shoes and shod Toney and cut some hay for to night and enough for feed tomorrow night. Omar split wood and backed the hay in that I mowed. Billy Rich come down and got the drag saw this morning.

Wed., May 21 clear

Omar and I went to salt. we saw 54 head-corn ear has a little heifer calf we salted 10 head in dough hailer and the rest of them was in Mule Creek. We got home 6.30. Meris Byrnes come about 9 Pm and we played pinochle until 11 Pm and he went home.

Thurs., May 22

I hewed potatoes here by the berries and I hewed one row of tomatoes and the row and a piece that I set in the young berrie row. I changed what water that was coming 3 times but I saw Edd going up the ditch to get the water at 4 Pm. Omar split wood, and Omar and I went over and helped Edd mark a slick ear and pinch one bull calf.

Fri., May 23 clear high 94

I cultivated the berries, Beans and corn and hewed the onions, carrots and beets and weeded them and cut hay for the stock. Omar split wood.

Sat., May 24 clear high 88

I hewed garden and Omar finished splitting the wood that Edd and him sawed. We killed a rattle snake by the front porch. We went to graze in the evening got home about 1 a.m. Sun morning.

Sun., May 25 clear

Verna and I went to the cemetery and cleaned the leaves from around the graves and just as we was about finished Helen, Lewis and Honey come and we visited a while and started about 12 noon. I went to bed 2 Pm and got up 5 Pm Omar and Edd went up the road after some of Edd's cattle they found them up Frinch Gulch and Edd and Omar drove them up Mule Cr. in the after noon

Mon., May 26 tem 52 cloudy

I irrigated the potatoes and the orchard and put the rest of the time resting. Omar mowed along both sides of the floom and backed the hay up and scattered out in the barn a.m. P.m. he howed the beans and sweet corn and after sunner he mowed the ditch that runs down to the garden by the barn

Tues., May 27 tem 55

Omar and I went to Medford and we took the radio and had new batreys put in it they charged us \$10.83 I got a box of copper rivets .50 and lunch .25 collar pad exchange I had to give .10 difference D D T(?) \$100 the bill at Bens \$1.78 and money order .28 tobacco, Alkasaltzer \$1.30 Gass \$2.90 We got home about 1 P.M. Omar put poles in the peas and tied them up Edd turned the water down 430 Pm

Wed., May 28 cloudy

I irrigated and mowed hay for the stock and pulled the runners of the strawberries. Omar Verna and I went to the Grange Hall to a meeting for electricity the Conso man was there and gave us the figures on what it would cost us

Thurs., May 29

I irrigated and mowed some hay along the fince on the uwer side and I mowed along the ditch that runs down to the floom. Omar howed corn a.m. and packed some hay in for the stock that I mowed with scythe. Edd and Viola went to the cabin at Bun(?) Gulch to fix the pasture fence

Fri., May 30 tem 56 cloudy

I irrigated and this evening I mowed some hay in the calf pasture for the bull and horses and evening feed out side for the milk cows. Omar and Verna set out 2 rows of cabbage and Omar put water on the tomatoes potatoes and straw berries. Lewis and family come 1230 Pm and was here for dinner and supper they left about 730 Pm

Sat., May 31 tem 48

I irrigated and Omar and I correlled 4 head of Edds cattle and went up and cleaned the Grouse Cr. rack got back just at noon I cut some hay along the looser end of the floom and mowed part of the ditch that runs east from the floom. Omar went to look for some fir poles to make a tongue for the rake and backed the hay in that I cut with the scythe.

Sun., June 1 tem 52 rain

It rained all day and hard part of the time I irrigated and mowed hay for the cows and bull Lewis, Rosley, Charles and Mary came for dinner and stayed until 5 P.M. We played pinochle Lewis and I played Verna and Rosley Lewis and I never lost but one game out of 4

Mon., June 2 tem 40 cloudy

I irrigated and mowed the ditch at the lower end of the floom and mowed some for the cows at the far end of the piece above the telephone line Omar got out some bean poles and got 2 poles for the rake tongue and he is putting them in the beans after supper. Edd and Viola got home from the mts. about 3 Pm Edd said the feed is getting pretty good up in the high range

Tues., June 3 tem 50 sprinkled

I irrigated and mowed hay for the stock Omar and Edd split wood

Wed., June 4 tem 48 cloudy

I finished irrigating 5:30 a.m. and shod twister and mowed some hay for the milk cows a.m. Omar and Edd finished splitting wood ricked some a.m. and Omar Verna and I went over to Edd to a telephone meeting and the assment was \$7.00 I paid Reich \$25.00 for cutting wood Edd took the water 5 Pm.

Thurs., June 5 tem 52 rain

Verna Omar and I went to Medford. Omar staid over to go to lodge Verna and I took dinner with Rosley Polky and Lucile come just as we were going to sit down to dinner I got a scythe blade \$2.25 bolts .25¢ and cup grease .15¢ gas 1.75. Verna got a cover for the davenport \$10.95 horse shoes .85 rolled barley \$3.00 lard and bacon \$3.25 and the bill at Miller grocery \$3.30. Verna got a pair of stockings 49 handkerchiefs 10

Fri., June 6 cloudy

A few light showers snowed on top of Siskiyous Omar and I went selling we saw 43 head of cattle with the ones Edd saw in the whole and 2 slick ears We saw the trail crew above the watering trough on Gray back trail Omar saw 3 bucks at Windy Camp spring

Sat., June 7 tem 50 cloudy, a few light showers

Omar went up the gulch to put salt out and Omar and I put the tongue in the mow and made a tongue and put it in the rake and cut hay for the stock and Omar packed it in. Edd and Soney and Leora come about 4 Pm

Sun., June 8 tem 56 cloudy, a few showers
high tem 66

I worked on the rake and mower a.m. Pm Omar and I ground sickles Omar nixed cherries a.m. and nixed a few for Leora just after dinner Edd and Leora started home about 3 Pm

Mon., June 9 tem 48 cloudy

Verna, Leora, Soney, Helen and I went to Ashland. We called on Nellie Long and Edna Phillips. Omar watched the pigeons out of cherries and cut hay for the stock.

Tues., June 10 tem 48 cloudy

Omar and I picked cherries a.m. Pm Omar picked cherries and I mowed corners and mowed some for the stock. After supper we took some cherries for Rosley and Russel and Malba down to Sunny Side and meet Lewis Rosley Mary Charles and Roney. Roney and Charles come home with us.

Wed., June 11 tem 40 a.m. clear

I mowed hay 7 hrs and I mowed corners and ditch until 8.20 Pm. Omar put poles in the string beans a.m. Pm Omar raked some hay in for the stock and hewed part of garden by the barn.

Thurs., June 12 tem 40 clear

I mowed and raked 8 hrs. Omar hewed garden and ground a sickle after supper. Edd mowed ditches and corners and helped fix a swather (?) board about 6 hrs.

Fri., June 13 tem 48 cloudy

Fog this morning. Clear most of day. I mowed and raked 8 hrs. Omar and Edd shocked hay from about 10 a.m. Edd mowed ditches this morning while the dew was on. Edd worked about 8 hrs. Omar hewed strawberries while the dew was on the hay.

Sat., June 14 tem 44 clear

I mowed a.m. and raked and raked 1 hr 30 min Pm and shocked from 2.30 until 5.15. Omar put the water on the garden by the barn and Omar, Roney, Charles and Edd shocked. Started shocking 10 a.m. Edd mowed ditches this morning. Charles and Roney shocked about 4 hrs. to day.

Sun., June 15 cloudy

I mowed hay this four noon. Edd Omar, Charles shocked a.m. and Edd Omar and I shocked this after noon finished shocking all that was raked. Ernie and Helen come about 11.30 and just left 8:15.

Mon., June 16 rain

Edd, Omar and I hauled 1 load of hay to the cow barn and it started raining about 6.30 and rained until 2 pm. I thinned the peaches and Omar and I thinned most of the apples.

Tues., June 17 tem 60 clear

I mowed ditches and I mowed over where the road comes up from the ford. Mowed until 3 pm I raked from 3 pm until 5:30 pm. Omar and Edd went up to Fir camp but didn't find any thing but some of Morris Byrnes cattle. Rosley Mary and Mrs. Wright and her 2 girls come out with Rosley. Rosley brought a sack of sugar out from Edd Pease. Charles went over to his music lessons. Mary staid out with us.

Wed., June 18 clear

Edd, Omar, Charles and I shocked and we shocked hay 8 hrs. I raked 2 hrs.

Thurs., June 19 tem 8 am 55 cloudy

Edd, Omar, Charles and I hauled 9 loads of hay to the big barn and shocked 5 acres of hay in 11 hrs.

Fri., June 20 tem 46 cloudy

Edd, Charles Omar and I hauled 12 loads of hay in 11 1/2 hrs. 10 loads in the cow barn.

Sat., June 21 tem 5 a.m. 36 frost

Omar, Charles Edd and I hauled 11 loads of hay 10 hrs. Rosley come out after Mary and as she was going back she broke the stirring gear on Billys gulch. Alice and her boy come with her and they took our car and went home and brought Lewis out. They staid all night and this Sunday morning they went down and fixed the car so they could drive it home.

Sun., June 22 tem 46 clear

36 loads of alfalfa first crop

Omar, Edd, Charles and I hauled 3 loads of hay this morning. Lewis and Polky helped with 2 loads. Polky and Lucile come about 9 a.m. I went up to first gulch and turned what water there was down but that wasnt much. I put it on the pasture. Leora, Soney and Eddie come out 9:30 a.m. Albert Culy come about 12 noon and went back 3 pm and the rest of them left shortly after Albert did and Omar, Verna and I went up and cleaned the rack and there wasnt much water and we went on up to the waist gate at Jollys and found the pipe across from Bert Harr's was blocked and it took us about 2 hrs to clean it out. We got home about 7 Pm and I fixed to run the water on the piece by the foot bridge.

Mon., June 23 tem 46 clear tem 2 am 80

I started irrigating this morning with a good head and the water slackened and I went up the ditch and John and Frank Collings was using part of it. John had 2 taps open and Frank had one open. I cultivated the garden this morning. I saw about 20 head of Edds cattle some of them was above Brushy Gulch and 5 on Wetters Flat. Frank and John Collings put a head of water in yesterday. 45 loads with that I sowed oats with.

Tues., June 24 5 a.m. 46 clear tem 2 am 94

I mowed oats and irrigated and after we got the milking this evening I mowed with scythe until 8:30 Pm. Omar put the water on the beans, berries and corn a.m. and mowed along the edges where I mowed over by the plumb tree that Lewis set out a.m. P.m. Omar shocked hay for Edd Finley.

Wed., June 25 clear

I finished mowing oats 10 a.m. and changed the water and raked hay until noon and changed the water and raked until 4 pm and then I mowed a ditch and shocked 11 shocks and changed the water and Omar and I did chors and shocked until 9 pm I changed the water 8:30 pm

Thurs., June 26 tem 53 cloudy

I went to Medford and got my operators licence 1.25 and sack of rolled barley \$8.00 and some groceries sack flour \$8.29 lard \$1.50 gas 1.80 tobacco 83 Omar shocked hay over to Edd Charles and Omar shocked after supper Charles and I got home 12 noon

Fri., June 27 tem 53

I irrigated Mowed ditch, raked some hay and shocked hay. Charles shocked 6 hrs and helped load a jag of hay that we put in the barn too wet and we are going to put it in the big barn to dry Omar shocked hay for Edd

Sat., June 28 clear

Omar, Charles and Edd hauled 4 loads of oats and alfalfa this four noon. I drove derick and Edd raked hay over at his place this after noon and Charles, Omar, and I hauled 4 loads but didn't fork the fourth load off. I changed the water 5 times today there was 9 head of cattle come in over at Edd just as it was getting dark. Omar's droop horn heifer with bell on was in the bunch and snooks and her calf fatty grub and her calf Crop ear's yearling and the rest was about yearlings

Sun., June 29 tem a.m. 38 clear

Omar, Edd and Charles drove 10 head of our cattle up to the powder house at Cougar Cr the cow with spot on her jaws calf was in the bunch and when I went around with the car its Mother was at Edds salt box but I couldn't drive her up the road Omar and Edd helped Charles up to Riches and I over took Charles this side of Sausw Cr. Lewis, Mary, Lucile, Rosley and a woman and 2 little boys come with them Bubbles calf born some time last night

Mon., June 30 tem a.m. 44 clear

I irrigated and drove derick for Edd Albert Collings and Omar picked and mowed the hay in the barn they hauled 9 loads Tier-dron and calf and the white neck heifer and calf come in to Edds about 5 pm. I mowed a ditch this four noon

Tues., July 1 tem a.m. 48 clear

Omar, Edd and Albert Collings hauled 12 loads of hay for Edd I drove derick and irrigated

Wed., July 2 tem a.m. 48 clear a.m. cloudy pm

Omar and I helped Edd haul 2 loads of hay a.m. and Omar went down to Rins after a small load of old hay that he cut about 6 weeks ago Omar got home about noon I told Fred to take the water 3 pm I mowed around the edge of the yard with scythe this evening and ground the scythe and Verne's cross cutter Verne mowed the lawn. It sprinkled a few drops about 6 pm

Thurs., July 3 ten a.m. 48 clear

Verna, Omar and I went to Medford I got 300# of salt \$3.90 shoe shine .15 Shoes \$9.00 horse shoes 1.10 Latigo (?) \$150 dinners \$100. Whisky \$2.90 sawney 4.45

Fri., July 4 ten 50

Charley Madson* and wife, Joe Madson and wife Lewis Culy and Rosley Mary Charles was here for dinner and we went to the dance to help with supper. We got home about 2 Pm Sat morning

*(Rosalia's maiden name was Madson (sp?))

Sat., July 5 clear

Verna, Omar, Rosley, Mary, Charles and I met Alma and Albert and we went up French Gulch and Omar and Charles went down Kilgor (?) to the spring and Omar and Albert went from the divide around in the left fork of French gulch and they found the cattle that Harry Helms saw at his place yesterday and we drove them up to the Cougar powder House. We got home about 330

Sun., July 6 ten 52 a.m. clear/cloudy in evening

I cultivated the corn and Omar and I pulled weeds out of the potatoes We went over to Scoville for 1 hr and 30 min There was 6 head of cattle come down this side we saw them about 6 Pm in the cow pasture there was net and calf and nets yearling sparky and the tinkleys (?) bell cows long(?) yearling and the 2 year old steer that we led up from the palmer (?) field

Mon., July 7 ten a.m. 56 clear
Foggy until 10 a.m.

We got home 8 Pm We corralled them in Ed correll We saw Harry Wolf and Bill Fruit* working trail at the head of Dough Hollow

Wed., July 9 clear until 430 thunder clouds come up We heard distant thunder there was a few drops fall here

Omar and I drove the cattal that we got from Gray Back yesterday up to the powder house a.m. P.m. didnt do any thing but fix the lead wire to the radio we put a new one in.

Thurs., July 10

Omar and I hewed the potatoes and tomatoes and the row of strawberries and 3 Pm I went up and cleaned the Grouse Cr. rack and Omar put the water on the tomatoes, Berries, Beans and 1 row of sweet corn. I put the water on the yard

Fri., July 11 ten 50 a.m. cloudy

Omar and I hewed corn finished all the corn but one row of sweet corn that was too wet to hew. Edd turned the water down about 430 Pm

Sat., July 12 cloudy

I irrigated. Omar put the herb wire across the river to keep the cattle out. I helped a little while we went to grange. Viola, Edd and Mrs. Scovell went down with us we got home about 12 mid night. Edd drove 8 head of his cattle up above Daves place his bull was in the bunch

Tuesday Verna, Omar, and I took the calf over to Ferless Market it weighted 298 1/2 # and we got \$98.34 for it. Mary Leu come home with us. We got home about 4 pm and we went over to Scovells for supper

Wed., July 23 clear

Omar and I went up and got 6 head of cattle: Cherry and calf a big long yearling steer that looks like the bell steer, Windoms yearling heifer The Tinkley bell cows yearling and Curley face long yearling Sparky

Thurs., July 24 tem 44 clear/cloudy

I put the kind shoes on twister this morning and mowed sweet clover the rest of the four noon and I mowed sweet clover 3m. Omar cut 2 poles for the electric line and 3 poles and done some weeding

Fri., July 25

I mowed sweet clover most of the day. Omar cut and resled 4 poles for the electric line

Sat., July 26 tem 56 rain

It started raining 9 o'clock last night and has been steady drizzle all the time with good showers quite often and is still raining at 8 pm. Omar and I didnt do much. Omar ground 3 sickles and I tried to fix the lenum in the kitchen and changed what water was coming 3 times. Omar went down to Maris Brnes for the evening

Sun., July 27 rain showery all day

Edd turned the water down 11 a.m. I mowed ditches until 11 a.m. Pm I irrigated and packed the hay in that I mowed along the ditches Omar cut 2 light poles

Thurs., July 31 tem 62 partly cloudy

I irrigated and went up and cleaned the Grouse Cr. rack and Went up to the west gate at Jollys and put the boards back in and put in more water and went up to Carbury Bridge to see if the 2 bull cows crossed the bridge I think they did as there was cow tracks crossing the bridge Omar cut light poles

I irrigated and shod twister in Trint and put the door casins back on and put the door in a.m. Pm I just changed the water Omar finished the light poles

Tues., Oct. 7 tem 5 a.m. 46 rain

I finished irrigating and finished fixing the dams in the ditches to turn the water in to the river a.m. Pm. Verna and I went down to the Grange Hall to vote Edd and Leora started out here and got as far as Evans place and Soney got sick and they went back to town

Wed., Oct. 8 tem a.m. 44 rain

Verna Omar and I went to Medford got home 4 Pm. When we got home Edd, Leora and Soney and Mr Zimmermen was here. We ate dinner with Edd and Leora
